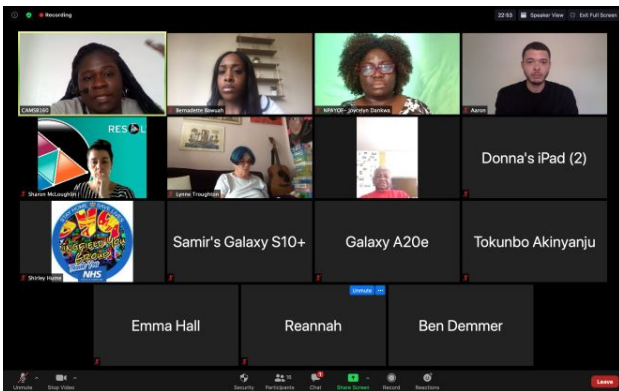
Congratulations to the National Parents and Youth Open Forum!

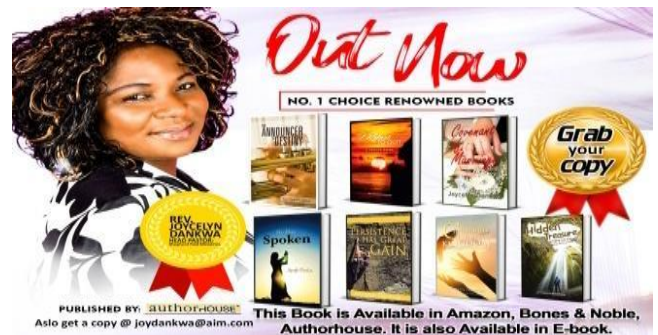
